



Basic course MRI in Radiotherapy for radiation therapists

The use of MRI in radiotherapy has steadily increased in recent years. Consequently a need has arisen to know and understand the implementation, image-recognition/interpretation and workflow of MRI for radiotherapy applications. This course is intended for radiation therapists aspiring to learn about the use of MRI in radiotherapy. It is open to those already working with MRI in radiotherapy or for radiation therapists wanting to do so. The aim of the course is to cover the clinical and physical aspects of MRI in radiotherapy from a practical point of view during morning lectures. In the afternoon practical examples will be studied in hands-on sessions.

The course is scheduled on **12th, 13th and 14th of December 2017** from 9:30 to 17:30. The venue is UMC Utrecht Cancer Center, the Netherlands. The course language will be English.
