Treasurer's Report 2025-26

Members of the British Institute of Radiology, I assumed the role of Honorary Treasurer on 1 October 2025. Accordingly, I am presenting the financial report for the 12 months ending 31 March 2026 on behalf of myself and the outgoing Honorary Treasurer, Dan Pounder.

Income for the 12 months to 31 March 2026 was £1.990 million compared to £1.987 million in the 12 months to 31 March 2025.

The principal sources of revenue are publishing (£1,167k), education (£407k), membership (£250k) and dividend income from the investment portfolio (£142k).

Expenditure for the year was £2.3 million for the 12 months to 31 March 2026 compared to £2.4 million for the 12 months to 31 March 2025. The principal areas of expenditure were publishing (£814k), education (£883k) and membership (£522k).

The value of the investment has risen over the year (£583k).

The BIR recorded a net surplus of £275k, in comparison to a net deficit of £566k in the previous year.
